SECOND COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND 7TH/8TH SEPT - EDUCATION SUNDAY

Education Sunday is one of the oldest days of special prayer in England and Wales which offers an opportunity to celebrate and give thanks to all involved in Catholic education. This second collection will go to The Blessed Edward Powell Trust.

We welcome pupils and staff back to our schools and pray that the new academic year will be a time of great blessings. The weekend of 7th/8th September is Education Weekend. St Joseph's School will lead the 9am Mass on Sunday 15th September.

We are most grateful to Fr Phil and Fr Tom for covering Masses for two weekends whilst I was on holiday.

Elaine will be away from the office for two weeks from Friday 7th returning on Monday 23rd September. We wish her a lovely break and thank her for all she does in the parishes.

Please note the times of Confessions. The aim is to finish a quarter of an hour before Mass so that there is time for the priest to prepare for Mass.

RECEPTION OF THE CHALICE

We will soon be looking to re-introduce the Chalice at all Masses. Before this happens there will be meeting of Ministers of Holy Communion on Tuesday 10th September after morning Mass and coffee in Portishead and on Wednesday 11th September after the evening Mass in Nailsea.

We need to know who is a commissioned Minister and whether you wish to resume this ministry or to retire. We also need to know who is willing to take communion to the sick and who only wishes to be a Minister at Mass. Those visiting the sick need DBS clearance. Ministers will also be needed for times of Adoration.

We will resume the practice of receiving from the Chalice on the weekend of 13th/14th September and recommission Extraordinary Ministers at Masses on those days.
