ROOF UPDATE - ST FRANCIS

The long saga of replacing the roof windows in Nailsea is all complete. It is good to be back in the church. The situation now leaves the parish owing money. The project has cost in the region of £110,000. We have borrowed money to pay for all of this and thus owe £62,000 in loans. This puts a severe strain on the parish for the foreseeable future. There are other jobs that would be good to do, but they will have to go on the back burner until the loan is paid off.
